The adoption of the local sales and use tax in Williamson County Emergency Services District No 7 at the rate of two percent.



WHEREAS, the ESD Commissioners on December 11, 2020, has canvassed the results for the purpose of determining the official election outcome after a petition to recount; and





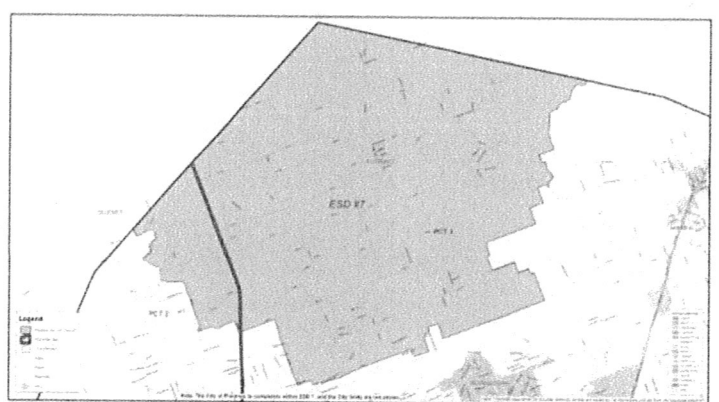
